

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** Section 17 to Article XVIII as follows:

**Section 17. Energy choice – definitions.**

(1) **DEFINITIONS.** AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

(a) “CONSUMER” MEANS AS ANY PERSON WHO IS THE BUYER OR USER OF A PRODUCT.

(b) “ENERGY” MEANS THE METHOD OF GENERATION OR THE FUEL SOURCE.

(2) **ENERGY CHOICE.** SUBJECT TO ARTICLE XXV OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, CONSUMERS SHALL HAVE A RIGHT TO ENERGY CHOICE THAT INCLUDES A RIGHT TO CHOOSE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES THAT ARE POWERED BY AN ENERGY SUPPLY CURRENTLY IN COMMON USE, SUCH AS SOLAR, WIND, ELECTRICITY, NATURAL GAS, AND PROPANE, AND THIS ENERGY CHOICE INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING APPLICATIONS:

(a) CURRENT AND FUTURE ENERGY SERVICE CONNECTIONS IN A HOME OR BUSINESS;

(b) PURCHASE AND USE OF VEHICLES, AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT, OR SMALL POWER AND LAWN EQUIPMENT; OR

(c) PURCHASE AND USE OF INDOOR AND OUTDOOR COOKING APPLIANCES, INCLUDING GRILLS; HEATING AND COOLING SYSTEMS; AND HOME APPLIANCES.

**SECTION 2. Effective date.**

This act shall take effect upon proclamation by the Governor announcing the approval, by the registered electors of the state, of the proposed initiative.
