On December 16, 2014, amendments to Regulation No. 2 CCR 404-1 were adopted by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, and pursuant to § 24-4-103(11)(d), C.R.S., the amended regulation, together with the Attorney General's opinion, was submitted to the Secretary of State within 20 days of promulgation under Tracking Number 2014-01070. Since then we have discovered an error within that filing that we would like to correct.


Pursuant to the rulemaking provisions of the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act, typographical and other nonsubstantive errors may be corrected upon submission of a request by the agency. C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II).

The following errors are corrected under Tracking Number 2015-00105:

The "clean" version of the final rule sent for publication mistakenly included the deletion of two reserved rules, Rules 338 and 339. Deleting these rules inadvertently moved Rules 340 and 341 up to 338 and 339. The "redline" version filed with the Secretary of State was correct. The corrected pages which can replace pages 97 and 98 of our prior submission are attached to this filing and will conform the published rule with the adopted rule.

In accordance with C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), I have reviewed these errors and have determined that they are typographical and nonsubstantive.
