Dear Mr. Williams:

I have reviewed your inquiry regarding the error made in the Rules of the Colorado Commission of Combative Sports ("Commission") adopted on April 12, 2018 and submitted to the Secretary of State on or about the same date. It is my opinion that the error in the rules as filed by the Commission in Rule 2.14 is non-substantive. The error is a simple typographical error, in that "state of tribal commission" should read "state or tribal commission." This is a non-substantive error and is correctable under section 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), C.R.S. Correcting the error by submitting the correct version of Rule 2.14 does not change the substantive content of the regulations, nor does it change the actual effective date of the regulations. Since the correction of this error does not change the substantive content of the regulation, it does not change the previous Attorney General opinion that this regulation is legal and constitutional.
