RE: Correction Request Tracking No. 2018-00299

Dear Secretary of State Williams:

On January 29, 2018, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") submitted an Attorney General's Rule Opinion, SOS Tracking No. 2017-00332, revising 4 Code of Colorado Regulations ("CCR") 723-2, of the PUC Rules Regulating Telecommunications Services and Providers of Telecommunications Services.

Colorado Legislative Legal Counsel brought to my attention that adopted Rule 4 CCR 723-2-2131(v), which includes the definition of a Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP") contains a nonsubstantive error. Consistent with C.R.S. § 29-11-101(6.5), a PSAP means a facility equipped and staffed "on a 24-hour basis" to receive and process 911 calls. The final version of the rule definition inadvertently omitted the phrase, "on a 24-hour basis," and should be corrected to include the underlined language as follows:

"Public Safety Answering Point" (PSAP) means a facility equipped and staffed to receive and process 9-1-1 calls from a BESP on a 24-hour basis.


On July 2, 2018, the PUC requested an administrative change to correct the error designated above, along with a corrected version of Rule 4 CCR 723-2-2131(v).

This correction is technical and non-substantive in nature and a clean version is enclosed for publishing in the CCR pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II).
