**CODE ENFORCEMENT AND CERTIFICATION OF INSPECTORS FOR PUBLIC
SCHOOLS, CHARTER SCHOOLS AND JUNIOR COLLEGES**

STATEMENT OF BASIS, STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AND PURPOSE

Pursuant to Section 24-33.5-1203.5, C.R.S., the Director of the Colorado Division of Fire Prevention and Control shall promulgate rules as necessary to carry out the duties of the Division of Fire Prevention and Control. This rule is proposed pursuant to this authority and is intended to be consistent with the requirements of the State Administrative Procedures Act, Section 24-4-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S.

The purpose of this rulemaking is to address legal deficiencies in Articles 4 and 7 identified by the Office of Legislative Legal Services (OLLS).

- Rule 4.3.1 stated, in relevant part, that "Qualified applicants shall comply with 10.1.2 A)." However, rule 10.1.2 A) was stricken from 8 CCR 1507-30 during the last revision cycle and thus cannot be referred to when determining compliance standards for qualified applicants. Therefore, this language is hereby removed and the correct reference to the new general rule, 8 CCR 1507-101, has been added.
- Rule 7.1.2 C) stated that "If the Division finds that inspections are not completed satisfactorily, or that all violations are not corrected, the Division shall take enforcement action against the appropriate Board pursuant to Article 11, and may require that the next project undertaken by the Board be delegated to the Prequalified Building Department." Because the previous version of Article 11 was stricken from 8 CCR 1507-30 during the last revision cycle, Article 11 now refers to "appeals" rather than "enforcement." To correct this, Article 11 for "enforcement" is hereby added back into the document. And as a result, the next three Articles are hereby renumbered to be Articles 12, 13, and 14.

Finally, two other small changes are made to the rules regarding notification to the Division (Rule 6.1.1) and the timing of inspection requests (Rule 7.4.1).
