## PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

### Office of Barber and Cosmetology Licensure

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rule is promulgated to implement Colorado House Bill 20-1326 (HB20-1326), concerning an expansion of an individual's ability to practice an occupation in Colorado through creation of an occupational credential portability program.

The basis for this rule is to carry out the provisions of HB20-1326 at section 12-20-202(3)(a), and the Barbers and Cosmetologists Practice Act at section 12-105-101 et seq., C.R.S.

The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking is pursuant to sections 12-20-204, 12-105-106(a), and 24-4-103, C.R.S. The adoption of this permanent rule is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law at section 12-20-202(3)(a), C.R.S. Therefore, I hereby adopt this permanent rule as printed and amended, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
