PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

Office of Direct-Entry Midwifery Registration

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rules are promulgated to implement Colorado Senate Bill 21-101 (*Concerning the continuation of the registration of Direct-Entry Midwives, and, implementing the recommendations contained in the 2020 sunset report by the Department of Regulatory Agencies*).

The basis for these rules are to carry out the provisions of Colorado Senate Bill 21-101, and the Direct-Entry Midwives Practice Act at section 12-225-101, et seq., C.R.S.

The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking is pursuant to sections 12-20-204(1), 12-225-108, and 24-4-103, C.R.S. The adoption of these permanent rules is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law. Therefore, I hereby adopt these permanent rules as printed and amended, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
