EMERGENCY RULE CONCERNING 7 CCR 1101-8, Emergency Conveyance Regulations

STATEMENT OF EMERGENCY JUSTIFICATION AND ADOPTION

Pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act, Title 24, Article 4, C.R.S., as amended, I, Richard O. Piper, Director of the Division of Oil and Public Safety, am adopting this emergency rule on behalf of the Division of Oil and Public Safety. I find the immediate adoption of this rule is imperatively necessary to comply with state or federal law or federal regulation.

Statutory Authority:

This Emergency regulation is promulgated under the authority of 9-5.5-116(1) C.R.S.

Purpose:

The purpose of this emergency regulation is to establish a process for the issuance of conveyance mechanic, inspector, and contractor licenses, which must be issued for these individuals or companies to perform work on conveyances in Colorado after January 1, 2008, pursuant to 9-5.5-106 C.R.S. The purpose of this emergency regulation is also to establish a date where as local jurisdictions must execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Division pursuant to 9-5.5-112(2) C.R.S. These emergency rules are necessary so that potential licensees are not unduly prohibited from conducting their business until permanent rules are promulgated, and so that local jurisdictions may continue to regulate conveyances until an MOA is executed, provided the jurisdiction has standards equal to or greater than adopted in 9-5.5-101 through 120 C.R.S.

This emergency rule is adopted and shall be effective on this 14th day of April, 2008.
