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ED 19-01-29-A, Revision to the Executive Rules concerning State Investigative Rules, Section 1.100

Executive Director. The proposed addition of State Investigative Rules at 10 C.C.R. § 2505-5(1.100), requested specifically by the Member Fraud Team. The proposed Rule creates the currently non-existent authority for State level investigation of member fraud, waste, and abuse.

The proposed Rule change would give the State Department of Healthcare Policy and Financing the subpoena power required to request important documents needed to effectively pursue a thorough investigation of member fraud, waste, and abuse at the State level. It would also create the State level authority, once a member fraud investigation has been completed, to review and terminate a member's eligibility and to establish overpayment claims and/or refer investigation findings for prosecution, as appropriate.

The statutory authority for this rule change is contained in 25.5-1-108, C.R.S. (2018).
