Each of the undersigned members of the Canvass Board of the Beebe Draw Farms Metropolitan District No. 2 certifies that the following is a true and correct abstract of the votes cast at the special election for the Beebe Draw Farms Metropolitan District No. 2, at which time the eligible electors of the District voted as indicated on the attached Judges' Certificate of Election Returns, and that the votes cast for and against the ballot issue submitted were as follows:

SHALL BEEBE DRAW FARMS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 2 TAXES BE INCREASED \$1,419,550 ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST COLLECTION YEAR OR BY SUCH OTHER AMOUNT COLLECTED IN FUTURE YEARS FROM A MILL LEVY NOT TO EXCEED 40 MILLS (WITH THE ACTUAL MILL LEVY RATE FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR TO BE ADJUSTED DOWNWARDS OR UPWARDS BY THE DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN ITS DISCRETION) TO PAY ADMINISTRATION, OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE EXPENSES, AND SUCH OTHER AMOUNTS AS MAY BE PAYABLE PURSUANT TO ONE OR MORE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS, PLEDGE AGREEMENTS OR OTHER CONTRACTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT DATED NOVEMBER 3, 2008 BETWEEN BEEBE DRAW FARMS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 1 AND BEEBE DRAW FARMS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 2, PROVIDED IN NO EVENT SHALL THE TOTAL COMBINED MILL LEVY FOR ADMINISTRATION, OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE AND DEBT EXCEED 40 MILLS; AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE MILL LEVY LIMITS DESCRIBED HEREIN SHALL BE ADJUSTED TO ACCOUNT FOR CHANGES IN THE METHOD OF ASSESSED VALUATION OR ANY CONSTITUTIONALLY MANDATED TAX CREDIT, CUT OR ABATEMENT AND WITHOUT ANY OTHER CONDITION FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH EXPENSES AND AMOUNTS DUE, AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND ANY INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT IN FISCAL YEAR 2010 AND IN EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, THE LIMITS IMPOSED BY SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S., IN ANY YEAR, OR ANY OTHER LAW WHICH PURPORTS TO LIMIT THE DISTRICT'S REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES AS IT CURRENTLY EXISTS OR AS IT MAY BE AMENDED IN THE FUTURE, ALL WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?

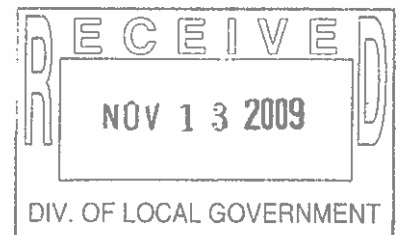
