SHALL HERITAGE GREENS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT DEBT BE INCREASED \$2,750,000 WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF \$8,250,000 OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY, AND SHALL HERITAGE GREENS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT TAXES BE

- REPLACEMENT OF THE SWIMMING POOL AT THE RECREATION CENTER FACILITY INCLUDING INCIDENTAL AND APPURTENANT FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT IN CONNECTION WITH REPLACEMENT OF THE RECREATION CENTER FACILITY AND SWIMMING POOL INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PUMPING SYSTEMS, FILTRATION AND HEATING EQUIPMENT; AND
- REPLACE OR REPAIR ANY RECREATIONAL FACILITIES LOCATED ON THE COMMON AREA OF THE RECREATION CENTER FACILITY INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE PARKING AREA, THE VOLLEYBALL COURT AND THE TENNIS COURTS

BY THE ISSUANCE AND PAYMENT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR OTHER EVIDENCE OF DEBT, SUCH DEBT TO BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 8.5% PER ANNUM, AND BE ISSUED, DATED AND SOLD AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES, AT SUCH PRICES (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER, CONTAINING SUCH TERMS AND BE IN SUCH FORM, NOT INCONSISTENT HERewith, AS THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT MAY DETERMINE; SUCH DEBT TO BE PAID FROM ANY LEGALLY AVAILABLE REVENUES OF THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING THE PROCEEDS OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES TO BE IMPOSED UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT WITHOUT LIMITATION AS TO RATE; TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF ANY SUCH DEBT AND THE REVENUE FROM SUCH TAXES, ANY OTHER REVENUE USED TO PAY SUCH DEBT, AND INVESTMENT EARNINGS THEREON, BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW WHICH PURPORTS TO LIMIT THE DISTRICT'S REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES AS IT CURRENTLY EXISTS OR AS IT MAY BE AMENDED IN THE FUTURE, AND WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?
