The Colorado Secretary of State (Secretary) seeks a stay pending appeal of a judgment of the United States District Court for the District of Colorado permanently enjoining the State of Colorado, its officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and any other person or entity in active concert and participation with any of them, from enforcing Colo. Const. art. V, § 1(2.5). In considering whether to grant a stay pending appeal, this court evaluates the following factors: the basis for its jurisdiction; the movant's likelihood of success on the merits; the threat of irreparable harm if relief is not

granted; the absence of harm to opposing parties if relief is granted; and the risk of harm to the public interest. *See* 10th Cir. R. 8.1.

Having considered the motion for stay, the appellees' opposition, the reply, and the relevant orders of the district court in light of the governing standards, this court grants the Secretary's motion. The injunction entered by the District of Colorado in its Final Judgment of March 27, 2018, is stayed during the pendency of this appeal.
