



STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

April 19, 2018


On March 20, 2018, Guinn Unger Jr., Democratic candidate for Colorado State Senate, District 6, submitted 1,538 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 26, 2018 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Unger's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary of State has determined that Mr. Unger submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2018 Democratic Party primary election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

<sup>1</sup> Under section 1-4-801(2)(b), C.R.S., a major party general assembly candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand signers or signers equal to thirty percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . ."
