- A watcher may be appointed for a recall election in the same manner as in a primary election. Watchers may be appointed for a recall election for a recall election by Each Qualified Successor Candidate, the proponents AND OPPONENTS OF THE RECALL BALLOT QUESTION, AND EACH PARTICIPATING POLITICAL PARTY FOR A PARTISAN RECALL ELECTION.
