**Subject:** SOS Rulemaking -- Vote Center Staffing

I strongly believe that the staff (volunteer or not) within a voting location should never include individuals from the same household -- especially if one of those people is in any position of authority with the voting location. I stopped volunteering at vote centers because Adams County continues to allow a husband to be in charge of the vote center and his wife to work there also -- it causes major problems with the wife taking charge, making demands and decisions she should not (to include bumping people through the voting line) and I believe a conflict of interest for the voters since the two of them are from different parties and are verifying the ballots and tapes from the electronic machines for each other -- how is that a good thing? I sent a letter to the County Clerk in Adams County at the time and received no response.
