Signature Verification

One Watcher per (candidate/party/issue committee) for every 4 signature verification judges may be present at any one time. For example:

It is possible that, during a very close race, Watchers could outnumber judges.

Watchers are limited to 10 challenges (per hour/per Watcher). The **Signature** Verification Lead will keep track of any issues or obtrusiveness. shown

Sig Ver Challenges

If a Watcher presents a challenge/interrupt card to you or your team:

- 1. Pause your work
- 2. Get the supervisor
- 3. Let the Watcher & supervisor complete the challenge form
- 4. The supervisor may ask you to explain your decision to the Watcher
- 5. If the Watcher is not satisfied, we will send that particular ballot to a bipartisan team (or second bipartisan team) if the Watcher demands.
