## 7.5.9 why 10 ballots? Shouldn't it be 1 person = 1 ballot?

7.5.9 : "RECEIVING more than 10 ballots in addition to his or her own in any election," appears to be in conflict with 7.2.1: "it is a violation of law to receive more than ten ballots for mailing or delivery in any election"

7.5.14: " IF AN UNAFFILIATED ELECTOR RETURNS MORE THAN ONE BALLOT IN A PRIMARY ELECTION" should be changed to "an unaffiliated elector shall NOT return more than one ballot in any election" If the elector fails to follow such rule their vote shall be rejected for the election in object and the elector will be duly notified of such rejection as well as of the reason for such rejection.

If an elector returns more than one ballot their vote shall be rejected for the election in object and the elector will be duly notified of such rejection as well as of the reason for such rejection. The elector is allowed to return one ballot only whether it be blank, voted or null (explicitly voided by multiple selections, drawings, doodles, or complaints) any constructive complaints marked on the ballot shall be registered as an election record

7.5.14: "A BIPARTISAN TEAM OF ELECTION JUDGES MUST REVIEW THE BALLOTS TO DETERMINE THE ELECTOR'S INTENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S VOTER INTENT GUIDE." Appears to be in conflict with 8.15.9: "Attempt to determine how any elector voted."

7.6.1; 7.7.3; 7.8.2 The elector must read the rule sheet and correctly sign the envelope in the correct space available as instructed. If the elector fails to follow such rules their vote shall be rejected for the election in object and the elector will be duly notified of such rejection as well as of the reason for such rejection.
