Secretary of State: Regarding revision of election rules:

Amended Rule 2.5.4: PLEASE CLARIFY THIS AMENDMENT. The amended rule must clarify that in elections years of both presidential and state primaries, the party affiliation of the voter only applies to a single primary in the election cycle not all the primaries in the cycle.

Amended Rule 2.13.2: NO. This amendment would eliminate the requirement of election judges to maintain a log of new registered voters or of any changes made by register electors. These actions are critical to maintaining the integrity of fair and honest elections.

Amended Rule 8: No. This amendment would not allow poll watchers to have any electronic device or mobile phone in their possession in the vicinity of the polling place. This is problematic because, without these, watchers would be unable to report voting irregularities in real time.

Ballot Separation Options for Unaffiliated Voters: You have laid out 3 options for ballot separation for unaffiliated voters. While all three have some flaws, Option 1 is probably the best of the three proposed. This option would allow unaffiliated voters to receive all major party ballots and the return envelope would provide a method for the county to determine which party's ballot has been cast.

CHOOSE OPTION 1; however, please take all possible steps to create a failsafe method for ensuring voter anonymity.

Cross Jurisdiction Voting: NO. This would potentially encourage some counties to REDUCE the number of voting centers.
