		It is difficult to create specific "examples" without someone interpreting that doing so provides a subtle advantage to specific candidates.
		Suggest counties have the option of providing ranked choice voter instructions on an additional insert instead of on the ballot.
49	3-7	A two-card ballot will create voter confusion and incur additional costs. (Entire cost of separate ballot to be borne by entity utilizing Ranked Voting – or in IGA to be handled between county and entity.)
		Reporting results by precinct also incurs additional costs and has a domino effect which inflates the volume of every process. Suggest making it required only when it is required for all election results in that election.
