RULE 110 - CONTINUING EDUCATION

2.1 STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE

The purpose for the promulgation of these rules is to define and standardize continuing education requirements for Colorado licensed podiatrists. The statutory basis for the promulgation of these rules is found at sections 12-290-106(1)(a) and 12-290-119, C.R.S., as amended.

2.2 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Licensees must attest at the time of renewal that they have obtained a minimum of ten hours of continuing education sufficient to maintain currency in the field of podiatry.
