RE: Correction to Gaming Regulations, 1 CCR 207-1, Rule 3
RO Correction Number 2015-00451

Dear Ms. Maiolo:

Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), the following corrections to the above-referenced rule are not substantive changes, but are corrections to errors that occurred in the publication process of Rule 3, Regulation 47.1-325.

A review of Colorado Gaming Regulation 47.1-325 in the current Code of Colorado Regulations (CCR) reveals that several subparagraphs have been inadvertently deleted from the current publication in the CCR. The redlined version contained in RO Correction Number 2015-00451 shows the missing subparagraphs being added back into Regulation 47.1-325(3), (6) and (8).

A recent rule filing by the Division of Gaming ("Division") in Tracking Number 2014-01093, effective January 14, 2015, contained unclear instructions regarding the renumbering and movement of certain paragraphs resulting in the inadvertent deletion of the affected subparagraphs. The current correction filing, as seen in the redlined version, replaces the missing subparagraphs to 47.1-325(3), (6) and (8) where they were intended to be moved in Tracking Number 2014-01093, effective January 14, 2015.

A review of Secretary of State records demonstrates that these subparagraphs have existed in Regulation 47.1-325 for a long time. In the version of Regulation 47.1-325 that existed on November 30, 2014 (Tracking No. 2014-00963), the missing subparagraphs can be seen under 47.1-325(1), (3) and (5). The subparagraphs can also be seen all the way back to the November 30, 2006 version of the CCR (Tracking Number 2006-00480).

We appreciate your assistance in correcting these technical errors and the Division will endeavor to provide clearer instructions in the future when renumbering/moving paragraphs.
