
The correction addresses a typographical error in the rule, adopted July 25, 2018, submitted under Tracking Number 2018-00271, specifically:

The word “to” is missing in the first line of 7.4.3.1, between “determined” and “have”, in the sentence that should read: “.1 An employer or its agent shall not be determined to have engaged in a “pattern of failing to respond timely or adequately” if the number of such failures during the year prior to such request is fewer than three or less than three percent of such requests, which ever is greater.”
