To whom it may concern:

On March 22, 2018, Governor Hickenlooper signed into law Senate Bill 18-1023, Concerning the Nonsubstantive Relocation of Laws Related to Legalized Marijuana from Title 12, Colorado Revised Statutes, as Part of the Organizational Recodification of Title 12. Senate Bill 18-1023 serves the purpose of removing the Department of Revenue, Marijuana Enforcement Division's ("MED") enabling statute (the "Retail Marijuana Code") from Title 12, Article 43.4, and into Title 44, Article 12 of the Colorado Revised Statutes. This relocation of the Retail Marijuana Code, renders all references to the Retail Marijuana Code within the Retail Marijuana Rules, at 1 CCR 212-1, no longer accurate. As a result, the proposed correction is to update all statutory citation references contained in the Retail Marijuana Rules, at 1 CCR 212-2, with the now effective statutory citations at Title 44.

Pursuant to section 24-4-103(11)(I)(B), C.R.S., the corrections to 1 CCR 212-2 are occasioned by the General Assembly's relocation of the Retail Marijuana Code and such corrections meet the conditions specified in section 24-4-103(11)(I)(A), C.R.S. Attached to the MED's filing is a redline containing these corrections.
