Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-4-103(11)(d)(II), the following corrections to the above-referenced rule are not substantive changes, but are corrections to typographical and proofreading errors.

1 CCR 212-1 – Medical Marijuana Rules:

M 712 – The rule was corrected to substitute maximum limits of arsenic and cadmium for inhaled or audit product administered by metered dose nasal spray or pressurized metered dose inhaler, (E)(4), from 2 ppm to 0.2 ppm as a result of typographical errors.

Note that the parallel rules in the Retail Marijuana Rules, 1 CCR 212-2 Rule R 712, contain the correct maximum limits of 0.2 ppm.
