Pursuant to section 24-4-103(11)(I)(I), C.R.S., the Director of Professions and Occupations within the Department of Regulatory Agencies requests a correction to the statutory citations in the Colorado Physical Therapist Licensure and Physical Therapist Assistant Certification Rules, 4 CCR 732-1.
