I am providing this correction letter on behalf of the Colorado Division of Insurance regarding Emergency Regulation 20-E-01. Section 5.B.2. of the Regulation has been corrected to read as follows: "The requirements of Section <u>5.B.</u> do not apply to prescription drugs with a high likelihood of abuse, such as opioids" (emphasis added). This corrects a typographical error that originally appeared in the Regulation as follows: "The requirements of Section <u>5.C.</u> do not apply to prescription drugs with a high likelihood of abuse, such as opioids" (Emphasis added).
