Dear Secretary Griswold:

On May 21, 2025, the Water Quality Control Commission filed a correction to recently adopted amendments to 5 CCR 1002-55 (Regulation No. 55 – State Funded Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Programs). The correction consists of including the effect date of April 30, 2025, for the amendments, which was inadvertently not included in the version that was initially filed with your office.

I have reviewed the correction to the amendments to Regulation 55 and determined that it is a non-substantive error and that it is necessary in order to conform the published rules with the adopted rules. *See* § 24-4-103(11)(d), C.R.S. (“Upon written request of an agency, the secretary of state shall correct typographical and other nonsubstantive errors appearing in the rules as filed by the agency that occur after final adoption of the rules by the agency during the preparation of the rules for publication in order to conform the published rules with the adopted rules.”).
