PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

Office of Massage Therapy Licensure

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rules are promulgated to correct language in the rules that conflict with portions of the statutes in Colorado House Bill 20-1326, and Colorado Senate Bill 20-102 (sections 12-20-202(3) and 12-30-115(4), C.R.S.).

The basis for these rules are to carry out the provisions of Colorado House Bill 20-1326 at section 12-20-202(3), Colorado Senate Bill 20-102 at section 12-30-115, and the Massage Therapy Practice Act at section 12-235-101, et seq., C.R.S.

The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking is pursuant to sections 12-20-204, 12-20-202(3), 12-30-115, 12-235-118, and 24-4-103, C.R.S. Adoption of these permanent rules is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law, sections 12-20-202(3) and 12-30-115, C.R.S. Therefore, I hereby adopt these permanent rules as printed and amended, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
