PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

Office of Occupational Therapy

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rules are promulgated to implement Colorado Senate Bill 23-188 (Concerning Protections for Accessing Reproductive Health Care) and Colorado Senate Bill 23-265 (Concerning a Prohibition on a Regulator Imposing Discipline Against a Person Based on Certain Activities Involving Marijuana).

Basis

The basis for the repeal of these rules are to carry out the provisions of Colorado Senate Bill 23-188 and Colorado Senate Bill 23-265; and the Occupational Therapy Practice Act at section 12-270-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S.

Purpose

The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking are pursuant to sections 12-20-204, 12-270-116, and 24-4-103, C.R.S. The adoption of these permanent rules is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law and the Governor's Executive Orders. Therefore, I hereby adopt these permanent rules as printed and amended, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103, C.R.S.
