

PERMANENT RULE ADOPTION ORDER

Office of Massage Therapy Licensure

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The attached permanent rules are promulgated to implement Colorado Senate Bill 24-201 (SB24-201), concerning an increase in the hours of work in a massage therapy program required for licensure as a massage therapist. SB24-201 was signed by Governor Jared Polis (“Governor”) on June 7, 2024, and became effective upon the Governor’s signature.


Basis

The basis for the repeal of these rules is to carry out the provisions of SB24-201, and the Massage Therapy Practice Act at section 12-235-101, et seq., C.R.S.

Purpose

The specific statutory authorities that authorize this rulemaking are pursuant to 12-20-204(1), 12-235-118, and 24-4-103, C.R.S. The adoption of these permanent rules is imperatively necessary to comply with the requirements of state law and the Governor’s Executive Orders. Therefore, I hereby adopt these permanent rules as printed and amended, and incorporate by reference the statements of basis, purpose, and statutory authority, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(c), C.R.S.
