RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMINISTRATION OF LICENSING, FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY, CONTINUING EDUCATION AND REMEDIAL ACTION FOR WELL CONSTRUCTION AND PUMP INSTALLATION CONTRACTORS

2 CCR 402-14

Rule 8. Continuing Education

- 8.1 Every contractor who is licensed by the Board to contract for the construction of water wells and/or for the installation of pumping equipment and cisterns, or who holds a special license from the Board must complete, annually:
- a. eight (8) hours of continuing education training at programs or courses accredited by the Board.
 - b. no more than four (4) out the Board, in conjunction with the CE Committee, will determine through policy the number of the eight (8) hours of approved continuing education that can be obtained by internet or online participation.
 - c. no more than three (3) out the eight (8) hours of approved continuing education can be obtained from safety, CPR, First Aid, or other safety-related training.
 - d. Due to significant limitations on the ability of people to meet in person due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all hours of accredited continuing education taken by internet or online participation from January 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021, may be used to obtain the required hours of continuing education. This Rule 8.1.d is repealed effective February 1, 2021, unless further extended by emergency or permanent rule.
