1.2 Licensure by Endorsement

The purpose of this Rule is to clarify licensure by endorsement requirements pursuant to section 12-20-202(3) C.R.S.

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- A. To qualify for licensure by endorsement an applicant must:
 - 1. Possess an active license in good standing to practice audiology in another state or territory of the United States territory or in a foreign country; and

- **DB**. As set forth in section 12-30-115(3)(e), C.R.S., the requirement to disclose the conviction, guilty plea, or agency action ends when the provider_has satisfied the requirements of the probation or other limitation and is no longer on probation or otherwise subject to a limitation on the ability to practice the provider's profession.
- <u>EC</u>. A provider <u>needis</u> not <u>make therequired to provide the written</u> disclosure <u>required by this section</u> before providing professional services to the patient <u>inif any of</u> the following <u>instancesapplies</u> as set forth in section 12-<u>3</u>20-115(4), C.R.S.:
 - The patient is unconscious or otherwise unable to comprehend the disclosure and sign an acknowledgment of receipt of the disclosure pursuant to section 12-30-115(3)(d), C.R.S., and a guardian of the patient is unavailable to comprehend the disclosure and sign the acknowledgement;
 - 2. The patient visit occurs in an emergency room or freestanding emergency department or the visit is unscheduled, including consultations in inpatient facilities; or

- 3. The provider <u>who will be treating the patient during the visitproviding the professional</u> service to the patient is not known to the patient until immediately prior to the start of the visit<u>.; or</u>
- <u>F4.</u> <u>AThe provider who does not have a direct treatment relationship or have direct contact with the patient is not required to make the disclosure required by this section.</u>

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
