Emergency Rule:

Revised Rule 1, 1 CCR 204-30 – RULES FOR APPLICATION FOR A COLORADO ROAD AND COMMUNITY SAFETY ACT IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS 42-2-501 CRS

Statement of Emergency Justification and Adoption

Pursuant to sections 24-4-103, 42-1-204, and 42-2-114.5, C.R.S, I, Barbara J. Brohl, Executive Director of the Department of Revenue (“Department”), hereby adopt the aforementioned revised Rule 1, 1 CCR 204-30, which is attached hereto.

Section 24-4-103(6), C.R.S., authorizes the Department to issue emergency rules if the Department finds that the immediate adoption of the rule is imperatively necessary to comply with a state law or for the preservation of public health, safety, or welfare and compliance with the requirements of section 24-4-103, C.R.S., would be contrary to the public interest.

I find that immediate adoption of this revised rule is necessary to comply with House Bill 16-1415, enacted on May 4, 2016, which amended section 42-2-114.5, C.R.S. to increase certain fees charged by the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles. The effective date of the fee changes is July 1, 2016. Rule 1, 1 CCR 204-30, section 4.0 must be amended to reflect the fee changes, but the notice requirements under section 24-4-103, C.R.S. will not allow the Department to make the necessary rule amendments by July 1, 2016. Thus, it is imperatively necessary to adopt Rule 1, 1 CCR 204-30 as an emergency rule in order to conform Rule 1 to the amended statutes as of their effective date.

I find that the immediate adoption of this revised rule is imperatively necessary to comply with the statutory mandates of Part 1, Article 2 of title 42, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, and that compliance with the requirements of section 24-4-103, C.R.S. would be contrary to the public interest.

Statutory Authority

The statutory authority for these rules is found at subsections 24-4-103, 42-1-204, and 42-12-114.5, C.R.S.

Purpose

To amend the fees listed in Rule 1, 1 CCR 204-30, section 4.0 so that they conform to the fee changes in section 42-2-114.5, C.R.S. as of the effective date of those changes - July 1, 2016.

Adoption

For the reasons set forth above, I hereby adopt emergency Rule 1, 1 CCR 204-30, which is attached hereto and which shall be effective as of July 1, 2016. This emergency rule shall be in force for a period of one hundred and twenty days from the date of this notice, unless sooner terminated or replaced by permanent rules adopted in accordance with section 24-4-103, C.R.S.
