

Section 3-1-1 Conveyance Mechanic

- (3) The Administrator may add to the issued license an exclusion for performing work on specific conveyance equipment if the applicant has not provided to the Administrator proof that the person obtained adequate training on this equipment as included in one of the licensing methods listed in (2) of this Section. Type 1 and Type 4 licensees shall not perform work on escalators and moving walks unless the licensee:
- (a) ~~Has performed work on this equipment within 12 months of receiving initial or subsequent training approved by the Administrator, and has performed work on this equipment within the previous 12 months, or~~
 - (b) ~~Submits to the Administrator an affidavit, provided by the Administrator and executed by the employing Licensed Contractor, stating that the licensee is qualified to perform work on these types of conveyances.~~
- (4) A person who obtains a mechanic license shall also complete eight (8) hours of continuing education that has been approved by the Administrator, every two (2) years. ~~This continuing education must be completed during the previous twelve (12) months prior to license renewal.~~
- (5) If a Type 1 or 4 licensee is approved to perform work on escalators and moving walkways, the required continuing education shall also include training on this equipment in order to continue to be qualified to perform work on this equipment.
- (56) Following review of the application, the Administrator will notify the applicant of the approval or disapproval of the application. If approved, the notification will include the mechanic license number, the type of conveyance on which the mechanic may perform work, a license card, and a payment receipt. If not approved, the notification will include a description of the deficiencies in the application.
- (67) The conveyance mechanic license issued by the Administrator shall be valid for one (1) year. The Administrator may renew a license, provided the applicant submits the following:
- (a) Completed mechanic license application form.
 - (b) License renewal fee.
 - (c) Copy of certification indicating that the applicant completed continuing education required in ~~(4)~~ of this Section.
