

**PROPOSED STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE FOR AMENDMENTS TO
THE DIVISION OF OIL AND PUBLIC SAFETY CONVEYANCE
REGULATIONS, 7 CCR 1101-8**

BASIS: The Elevator and Escalator Certification Act, Title 9 Article 5.5 C.R.S., states that in order to ensure minimum safety standards throughout Colorado, the regulation of conveyances is a matter of statewide concern. These rules are being promulgated under the Division's authority pursuant to Title 9 Article 5.5 §116 of the Colorado Revised Statutes.

PURPOSE: These proposed regulations will identify procedures and requirements for the design, construction, operation, inspection, testing, maintenance, alteration, and repair of conveyances, such as elevators, platform lifts, personnel hoists, stairway chair lifts, dumbwaiters, escalators, moving walks, and automated people movers.

Pursuant to §24-4-103(4)(b), C.R.S., the Director finds that: 1) there is a demonstrated need for the rules; (2) the proper statutory authority exists for this regulation; (3) to the extent practicable, the rules are clearly stated so that their meaning will be understood by any party required to comply with the regulation; (4) the rules do not conflict with other provisions of law; and (5) the duplicating or overlapping of the regulation is explained by the agency adopting the rules.
