Notice of Public Rule-Making Hearing Scheduled for December 16, 2015

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of § 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on December 16, 2015 at 10 a.m. in the Sabin-Cleere Conference Room of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Bldg. A, First Floor, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive, South, Denver, CO 80246, to consider the promulgation of amendments to 6 CCR 1007-1, Radiation Control, Part 18, Licensing Requirements for Uranium and Thorium Processing. The proposed rules have been developed by the Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to Sections 25-1.5-101(1)(k), 25-1.5-101(1)(l), 25-11-103, 25-11-104, and 25-1-108, C.R.S.

Availability of the Agenda and the Proposed Amendments

The agenda for the meeting and the proposed amendments will also be available on the Board's website, <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/boh> at least 7 days prior to the meeting. The proposed rules, together with the proposed statement of basis and purpose, specific statutory authority and regulatory analysis will be available for inspection at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South, HMD-B2, Denver, Colorado 80246-1530 at least five working days prior to the hearing. Public Participation through Oral and Written Testimony

Testimony is limited to the subject matter and scope of the proposed amendments. The Board encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments, or by making oral comments at the hearing.

Written Testimony Encouraged

Submitting written comments prior to the rulemaking hearing provides the Board an opportunity to identify outstanding issues and adequately prepare for the rulemaking hearing. Pursuant to 6 CCR 1014-8, §3.02.1, written testimony must be submitted no later than five (5) calendar days prior to the rulemaking hearing. Written testimony is due by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, December 10, 2015. Information submitted by the deadline will be provided to the Board for review and consideration as part of the rulemaking hearing.

Oral Testimony May Be Limited

The oral testimony may be limited pursuant to 6 CCR 1014-8, §3.03. At the discretion of the Chair, oral testimony at the hearing may be limited to three minutes or less depending upon the number of persons who sign up to testify. The time allocated for each person or group to comment on the proposal will be based upon the number of persons wishing to comment and the time allocated for the hearing. Depending upon the number of individuals that sign up to testify, some individuals may not receive an opportunity to provide oral testimony.

Persons appearing for the Board who wish to provide oral testimony are encouraged to prepare and use clear and concise language to explain their points of view. Individuals or organizations that share the same perspective or position regarding the proposed amendments are encouraged to identify one spokesperson to testify at the hearing. The Hearing Chair shall limit duplicative or repetitive testimony, or testimony that is outside the scope of the proposed rulemaking.
