#### **RULE 8.1 OF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMINISTRATION OF LICENSING, FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY, CONTINUING EDUCATION, AND REMEDIAL ACTION FOR WELL CONSTRUCTION AND PUMP INSTALLATION CONTRACTORS (2 CCR 402-14)**

- Comments not designated as “testimony,” including comments submitted by interested persons not given party status, will be made available to the Board prior to the hearing and included as part of the public record.

### **Order Governing Participation in the Rulemaking Hearing**

- **On or before October 23, 2020** - An Order will be issued governing participation of parties and individuals at the rulemaking hearing.
- The Order will be distributed to the [BOE Info/News Notification List](#) and all parties who submit a Notice of Intent to Participate.
- The Order will allot specific times for party testimony.
- **Length of testimony allotted is reserved entirely to the discretion of the Board.**
