Notice of Public Rule-Making Hearing January 15, 2025

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 24-4-103, C.R.S., that the Colorado Board of Health will conduct a public rule-making hearing on January 15, 2025 at 10 a.m. in person at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South, Denver, CO 80246, remotely via [Zoom](#), or via both mediums, to consider amendments to 6 CCR 1011-7, Assisted Living Residences. The amendments are proposed by the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment pursuant to Sections 25-27-104, 25-27-114, 25-1.5-302, and 25-27-102, C.R.S., and are due to the passage of Senate Bill (SB) 24-167, which makes certain trainings and tests performed by individual assisted living residences (ALR) portable, meaning that an employee can carry it from one ALR employer to another without a need for retraining or retesting on the portable topic.

The agenda for the meeting and the proposed amendments will also be available on the Board's website, <https://cdphe.colorado.gov/board-of-health> at least seven (7) days prior to the meeting. The proposed rule, together with the proposed statement of basis and purpose, specific statutory authority and regulatory analysis will be available for inspection at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South EDO-A5, Denver, Colorado 80246-1530 at least five working days prior to the hearing. The Board encourages all interested persons to participate in the hearing by providing written data, views, or comments. Written testimony is encouraged; oral testimony will be received only to the extent the Board finds it necessary. Testimony is limited to the scope of the rulemaking hearing.

Oral testimony. For those that are permitted to provide oral testimony, the time may be limited to 3 minutes or less. The Board requires that those wishing to give oral testimony remotely sign up to do so no later than Tuesday, January 14, 2025 on the Board's website, <https://cdphe.colorado.gov/board-of-health>. Persons who wish to provide in person testimony may sign up to do so in the meeting room on the day of the hearing.

Written testimony. Pursuant to 6 CCR 1014-8, §3.02.1, written testimony must be submitted no later than five (5) calendar days prior to the rulemaking hearing. Written testimony must be received by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, January 9, 2025. Persons wishing to submit written comments should submit them by e-mail to cdphe.bohrequests@state.co.us or by mail to:
