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8 **Addition of Section 3.3.8 Training**

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11 **1) Section 3 is being amended by adding subsection 3.3.8 to read as follows:**

12 3.3.8 Training

13 (A) Owners and operators of all solid waste landfills shall develop and implement a training
14 program at the facility that ensures facility personnel are thoroughly trained in facility operations
15 relevant to each person's job duties at the facility.

16 (1) At a minimum, the training program applies to landfill managers, supervisors, operators
17 and facility personnel that collect groundwater samples or methane gas samples, conduct
18 facility inspections, check leachate levels, and/or review waste profiles or waste acceptance
19 documentation.

20 (B) The training program must include a written training plan that identifies the introductory and
21 continuing annual training each employee at the landfill will receive related to the management of
22 solid waste and personnel safety that ensures compliance with the solid waste regulations and
23 the facility's Engineering Design and Operations Plan (EDOP). At a minimum, the training plan
24 must include:

25 (1) A description of personnel training that ensures that hazardous waste, polychlorinated
26 biphenyls, and other prohibited wastes, as specified in the facility's EDOP, are identified and
27 restricted from disposal at the facility; and

28 (2) A description of personnel training that ensures that facility personnel are thoroughly
29 familiar with applicable portions of the facility's EDOP such that compliance with all aspects
30 of the EDOP is ensured.

31 (C) The following training records must be maintained at the facility:

32 (1) The name, job title and job duties for each employee at the landfill related to the
33 management of solid waste;

34 (2) Written documentation that records the type, date, and amount of initial and annual
35 training provided to each facility employee consistent with the training plan, and

36 (3) Documentation that facility personnel have received training within six (6) months of being
37 initially employed at the facility or being transferred to a position involving the management of
38 solid waste, and documentation that facility personnel did not work unsupervised until they
39 completed the training required in paragraph 3.3.8(A).

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(4) Training records must be made available for review during an inspection for all current facility personnel and maintained on-site for three years.
