## **NOTICE:**

By means of Senate Bill 07-221 and House Bill 07-1081, the Colorado Legislature required the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board (the "Board") and the Auto Industry Division (the "Division") to reformulate the Mastery Examination testing process. The goal was to increase the accountability of the process and to ensure the validity of test results. The Board and the Division have worked for several years to make the necessary changes in order to satisfy the Legislature's requirements. The Board used public rule-making to establish a relevant set of new and revised rules. The Division, in consultation with educational experts, developed a new Mastery Examination and adopted the Internet testing protocols to allow the examination to be taken on-line and reported electronically back to the Division. Additionally, the Division has made some changes in forms and licensing processes to be consistent with the changes in the Mastery Examination process.

Until August 30, 2010, the older version of the Mastery Examination as part of an associated, completed application, together with the specific procedures related to the older version of the Examination, remains valid. On August 30, 2010, the new version of the Mastery Examination, as part of an associated, completed application, together with the specific procedures related to the new version of the Examination, becomes the only valid version of the examination. Anyone taking the Mastery Examination on or after August 30, 2010, must take the new version online in accordance with the specific procedures for the new version.
