

Department of Health Care Policy and Financing PUBLIC NOTICE

February 25, 2013

Primary Care Provider Supplemental Payment

Effective January 1, 2013, and scheduled to end December 31, 2014, the Department intends to increase the reimbursement for a set of procedure codes for office visit and vaccine administration services. Only services provided by physicians who self attest to being a specialist in family medicine, internal medicine, or pediatric medicine and physician assistants and advanced practice nurses personally supervised by an attested physician are included in the increased reimbursement. The increased reimbursement will match the prevailing Medicare reimbursement for the non-facility rate for those services. For Medicare reimbursement, there is only one geographic adjustment, statewide, for Colorado. The increase is required by Section 1202 of the Affordable Care Act.

The Department expects this increase to be temporary expiring on December 31, 2014. The Department intends to submit the required State Plan amendment to CMS by March 31, 2013.

The reimbursement increase is necessary to comply with federal law. CMS has confirmed that the amendment to the State Plan must be approved before federal matching funds for the increased reimbursement, effective January 1, 2013, can be made available. Therefore the Department cannot provide a date for the expected first payments.

The reimbursement increase is forecasted to result in an increase in annual aggregate expenditures of \$6,298,666 for FY 2012-2013 and \$16,107,758 for FY 2013-2014.

The published rates on the fee schedule will not change for this increase. The reimbursement increase will be paid through a supplemental payment to the providers.
