Section 24-6-203, C.R.S.

This calendar applies to state, county or local elected candidates or incumbents, including Judges/Justices. All candidates or incumbents needing to file this report will file with the Secretary of State's office; except for municipal candidates/incumbents, who file this report with their municipal or town clerk.

Filing is only required if a candidate/incumbent has something to report; if nothing to report the filing is voluntary and not required but encouraged. Forms are available on the Public Official Disclosure page or the Campaign Finance page of the Secretary of State's website at www.sos.state.co.us.

This calendar **does not apply to** President, Vice President, U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, a political party office, or Special District offices where the annual compensation is less than \$1,200.
