NOVEMBER 7, 2017 BIENNIAL SCHOOL ELECTION SCHEDULE

This calendar applies to candidates, parties, and committees participating in the Biennial School Election. Please take time to carefully review the schedules to ensure you know which schedule to follow.

This schedule applies to **issue committees, parties, and candidates (including their committees)** whose issue or office attempts access to or appears on the Biennial School Election ballot.

October

17⁸ 21st Day before the Coordinated Election, Report covers October 28, 2016 or December 4, 2016 through October 12, 2017

November

3⁸ Friday before the Coordinated Election, Report covers October 13, 2017 through October 29, 2017

7 Biennial School / Coordinated Election

December

7⁸ 30th Day after the Coordinated Election, Report covers October 30, 2017 through December 2, 2017

This schedule applies to **political parties, political committees, small donor committees, independent expenditure committees, and 527 political organizations**, who participate in the Biennial School Election.

May

1 Monthly Report—Start date varies, concludes on April 26, 2017

June

1 Monthly Report covers April 27, 2017 through May 27, 2017

July

3[♦] Monthly Report covers May 28, 2017 through June 26, 2017

August

1 Monthly Report covers June 27, 2017 through July 27, 2017

September

5^{♦8} Biweekly Report covers July 28, 2017 through August 30, 2017

18⁸ Biweekly Report covers August 31, 2017 through September 13, 2017

October

2⁸ Biweekly Report covers September 14, 2017 through September 27, 2017

16⁸ Biweekly Report covers September 28, 2017 through October 11, 2017

30⁸ Biweekly Report covers October 12, 2017 through October 25, 2017

November

7 Biennial School / Coordinated Election

December

7⁸ 30th Day after the Biennial School Election report covers October 26, 2017 through December 2, 2017 (November 30, 2017 for state jurisdictions)

♦ Date affected by holiday or weekend

8 Electioneering Communication activity may be included on report

Notes: Due to a change in the law, **Electioneering Communication reports, 24 Hour Notice of Major Contributor reports, and 48 Hour Notice of Independent Expenditure reports are now required in odd calendar years.** The Electioneering Communication period begins 60 days before the election and the 24 & 48 Hour report periods begin 30 days before the election.

Small-Scale Issue Committees are not required to file disclosure reports until they exceed \$5,000 in activity. After filing an initial disclosure report and converting to an Issue Committee they are subject to the reporting requirements of 1-45-108(2), C.R.S.
