FILING CALENDAR

Applies to (refer to Campaign Finance Rule 17):

- State issue committees, with a jurisdiction type of “Statewide”, whose issue attempts access to or will appear on the November 7, 2017 Coordinated Election ballot

May

- 1 Monthly Report covers:
 - December 1, 2016 through April 26, 2017

OR

 - January 1, 2017 through April 26, 2017

June

- 1 Monthly Report covers April 27, 2017 through May 27, 2017

July

- 3♦ Monthly Report covers May 28, 2017 through June 26, 2017

August

- 1 Monthly Report covers June 27, 2017 through July 27, 2017

September

- 5♦ Biweekly Report covers July 28, 2017 through August 30, 2017
- 18 Biweekly Report covers August 31, 2017 through September 13, 2017

October

- 2 Biweekly Report covers September 14, 2017 through September 27, 2017
- 16 Biweekly Report covers September 28, 2017 through October 11, 2017
- 30 Biweekly Report covers October 12, 2017 through October 25, 2017

November

- 7 2017 Coordinated Election

December

- 7 Post-Election Report covers October 26, 2017 through November 30, 2017

- ♦ Date affected by holiday or weekend

Notes:

- Small-Scale Issue Committees (SSIC) are not required to file disclosure reports until they exceed \$5,000 in activity. After filing an initial disclosure report and converting to an Issue Committee, they are subject to the disclosure requirements of 1-45-108(2), C.R.S.
- Any committee participating in the November 7, 2017, Biennial School Election must file disclosure reports according to the 2017 Biennial School Election schedule. You must notify Campaign Finance Support to update your filing schedule immediately upon participating in the biennial school election.
- **Due to a change in law, the following types of report(s) are now required in odd calendar years:**
 - 24 Hour Notice of Major Contributor reports (starting October 8, 2017 through November 6, 2017)
 - Electioneering Communication reports—does not apply to Issue Committees
 - 48 Hour Notice of Independent Expenditure reports—does not apply to Issue Committees
