Notice: Due date shift for October 5th 2020 Report of Contributions and Expenditures

Dear Statewide Frequent campaign finance filers,

If you have not already filed your report of contributions due October 5, 2020, you should have received an automatic reminder of the upcoming due date from our filing system TRACER. We are writing to inform you of a shift in the due date for your October 5th report of contributions and expenditures.

Earlier this year, the Colorado General Assembly passed a new law making the first Monday in October a legal holiday in honor of Francis Xavier Cabrini. Because the originally scheduled report due on October 5th, 2020 now falls on a legal holiday, we are required to shift the report due date to the following business day (**Tuesday October 6th, 2020**). You can still file your report at any time and although our filing calendars still indicate a report is due October 5, 2020, the due date in your TRACER workspace should be updated to reflect the new due date of October 6th 2020. If you file this report before midnight on October 6th, 2020, it will be considered timely and you will not be penalized. The end of the reporting period for this report remains unchanged (September 30, 2020) and the reporting period for the next regularly scheduled report due October 19th, 2020 will begin on October 1st, 2020 as scheduled.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact our office. Although Monday October 5, 2020 is now a legal holiday, our team will still be available by phone or email to assist you that day with any campaign finance and TRACER questions you might have.
