Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** Section 13 to article <u>XVIII-VII</u> as follows:

Section 13. Signature verification.

A VOTER IS REQUIRED TO AFFIX THEIR SIGNATURE AND PROVIDE EITHER-THE LAST FOUR DIGITS OF EITHER THEIR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR STATE ISSUED STATE-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION CARD ON THE SELF-AFFIRMATION OF A MAIL BALLOT RETURN ENVELOPE. IF-IF THE VOTER FAILS TO FILL OUT ALL OR PART OF THE REQUIRED AFFIRMATION, OR IF AN ELECTION JUDGE IS UNABLE TO CONFIRM THAT THE INFORMATION PROVIDED MATCHES THE INFORMATION IN THE VOTER FILE, THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER OR OTHER DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL MUST SEND NOTICE TO THE VOTER INFORMING THEM OF THE PROCESS TO CORRECT THE DISCREPANCY.
