

ELECTION QUESTIONS:

A. SHALL HILLROSE RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$13,047.00 ANNUALLY (FOR COLLECTION IN CALENDAR YEAR 2011) AND BY SUCH GREATER OR LESSER AMOUNT EACH YEAR THEREAFTER AS MAY BE PRODUCED BY A MILL LEVY INCREASE OF NOT MORE THAN 1.0 MILL; SUCH TAXES TO CONSIST OF AN AD VALOREM MILL LEVY IMPOSED ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT, TO BE USED

TO PAY FOR EQUIPMENT INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION FIRE ENGINES, TENDERS, AND RESCUE EQUIPMENT TOGETHER WITH ALL NECESSARY INCIDENTAL AND APPURTENANT FACILITIES, AND EQUIPMENT;

TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTER PENSIONS;

AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON CONSTITUTE VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGES EACH YEAR AND BE COLLECTED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT EACH YEAR WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR SECTION 29-1-301, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, AND WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF THE OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?
