



(Notice By Publication)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, and particularly to the electors of the LAS ANIMAS COUNTY HEALTH SERVICE DISTRICT, Las Animas County, Colorado:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a countywide election will be held on the 4th day of May, 2010, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. At that time, two (2) directors will be elected to serve 4-year terms. Eligible electors of the Las Animas County Health Service District interested in serving on the board of directors may obtain a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form from the District Designated Election Official (DEO) Jesse Manzanares, 122 West First Street, Trinidad, Colorado 719-846-4447.

The Office of the DEO is open on the following days: Monday thru Friday, 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. If the DEO determines that a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form is not sufficient, the eligible electorate who submitted the form may amend the form once, at any time prior to 3:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010. The deadline to submit a Self-Nomination and Acceptance is close of business on Friday, February 26, 2010. Earlier submission is encouraged as the deadline will not permit during an insufficient form. Affidavit of Intent To Be A Write-In Candidate form must be submitted to the office of the designated election official by the close of business on March 1, 2010.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, an application for a mail-in ballot shall be filed with the designated election official no later than the close of business on Friday, April 30, 2010, except that, if the applicant wishes to receive the mail-in ballot by mail, the application shall be filed no later than the close of the business on Tuesday, April 27, 2010.

ELECTION RESOLUTION FOR 2010 REGULAR DISTRICT ELECTION
Las Animas County Health Service District
Resolution No. 10-1

WHEREAS, the terms of office of Directors Clay Hart and Jesse Manzanares shall expire after their successors are elected at the regular special District election to be held on May 4, 2010 ("Election") and take office; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Special District Act ("Act") and the Uniform Election Code of 1992 ("Code"), and the Election must be conducted to elect two (2) Directors to serve for a term of four (4) years.

Now, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Las Animas County Health Service District in the County of Las Animas, State of Colorado that:


1. The regular election of the eligible electors of the District shall be held on May 4, 2010, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. pursuant to and in accordance with the Act, Code, and other applicable laws. At the time two (2) Directors will be elected to serve a four-year term.
2. There shall be one election precinct for the convenience of the eligible electors of the District, the boundaries of which shall be identical to the boundaries of the District, and there shall be one (1) polling place at the following location:
122 West First Street, Trinidad, CO 81082
situated in the County of Las Animas, State of Colorado. The polling place located at 122 West First Street shall also be polling place for disabled electors and for eligible electors not residing within the District. If the Designated election Official deems it to be more expedient for the convenience of the eligible electors of the District (who are also eligible electors in other special districts with overlapping boundaries which are conducting elections of the Election day), the Election may be held jointly with such special districts in accordance with coordinated election procedure as set forth in an agreement between all participating special districts. In such event, the election precincts and polling places shall be as set forth in such agreement. The Designated Election Official is authorized to execute such agreement of behalf of the District, which agreement shall include provisions for the allocation of responsibilities for the conduct and reasonable sharing of costs of the coordinated Election.
3. The Board of Directors hereby designate Jesse Manzanares as the Designated Election Official of the District, who is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with any action necessary or appropriate of effectuate the provisions of the Resolution and the Act, Code, TABOR or other applicable laws. Among other matters, the Designated Election Official shall publish the call for nominations, appoint election judges as necessary, appoint the Canvass Board, arrange for required notice of election, including the TABOR notice, and printing of ballots, and direct that all other appropriate actions be accomplished.
4. If other special districts with overlapping boundaries of the District are conducting ballot issue election on the Election Day, the District is required to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with such special districts concerning the preparation and mailing of the TABOR Notice to the registered electors within the overlapping area. The Designated Election Official is authorized to enter into such agreement on behalf of the District.
5. Self-Nominated and Acceptance forms are available at the Designated Election Official's office located at the above address. All candidates must file a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form

with the Designated Election Official no later than the close of business, 3:00 P.M. on Friday, February 26, 2010.

6. If the only matter before the electors is the election of Directors of the District and if, at the close of business on March 2, 2010, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the Election, including candidates timely filing affidavits of intent no later than March 1, 2010, the Designated Election Official shall cancel the Election and declare the candidates elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published and posted in accordance with the Code.
7. Pursuant to Section 1-11-203.5, C.R.S./ any election contest arising out of a ballot issue or ballot question election concerning the order of the ballot or the form of content of the ballot title shall be commenced by petition filed with the proper court within five(5) days after the title of the ballot issue or ballot question is set.
8. If the only matter before the electors is the election of the Director of the District and if, at the close of business on March 2, 2010, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the Election, including candidates timely filing affidavits of intent no later than March 1, 2014, the Designated Election Official shall cancel the Election and declare the candidates elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published and posted in accordance with the code.
9. If any part or provision of the is Resolution is adjudged to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Resolution, it being the Board's intention that the various provisions hereof are servable
10. Any and all actions previously taken by the Designated Election Official or the Secretary of the Board of Directors or any other persons acting on their behalf pursuant to the Act, the Code or other applicable laws, are hereby ratified and confirmed.
11. All acts, orders, and resolutions, or parts thereof, of the Board which are inconsistent or in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.
12. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
