- ✓ 3. A copy of your district's most current bond ('current' implies 2009 or 2010). If you have questions about whether your bond is current, if it is sufficient, or if it is not, then what will suffice to comply with this statutory requirement, please call us).

The course began with a review of the principals of Incident Command System, common language, span control, familiarization with the standard ICS forms a how to run an incident utilizing the ICS system.


