OFFICIAL TO CANCEL ELECTION**


WHEREAS, pursuant to 1-11-111(2) C.R.S. the board of Directors of the Snake River Water District is authorized to designate an election official to exercise authority of the Board in conducting an election, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 1-5-208(1.5)(6) C.R.S., the Board can authorize the Designated Election Official to cancel the election upon certain conditions and publish said notice;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors for the Snake River Water District that: (1) The Board has named Barbara J. Mertus Munyon as the Designated Election Official for the regular District election scheduled for the 4th day of May, 2010, and (2) The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Designated Election Official to cancel said election and declare the candidates elected if at the close of business on the sixty-third day before the election there were more candidates for Director than offices to be filled at the election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent to be write-in candidates. The Board further authorizes and directs the Designated Election Official to publish and post notice of the cancellation at each polling place and in the offices of the Designated Election Official, Clerk and Recorder of each county in which the District is located, and file with the Division of Local Government within thirty (30) days of cancellation of election. The Board also instructs The Designated Election Official to notify the candidates that the election has been cancelled and they were elected by acclamation.

The Board also hereby designates the official polling place for this election shall be the District Administrative Offices as 50 Oro Grande Drive in Keystone, Summit County, Colorado.
